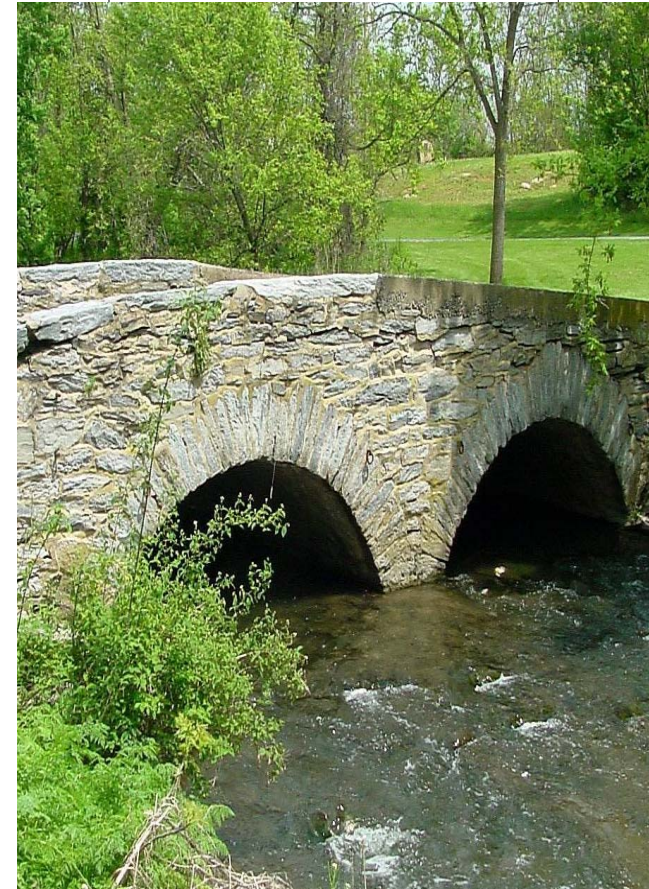
BECOME A MEMBER
